Through these experiences, young people will work together to develop ideas for community improvement, contribute to policy recommendations, and engage in dialogue with decision-makers at local and European levels.

We aim to establish a lasting network of youth organisations and youth groups that will continue promoting cooperation, peer learning, and policy dialogue beyond the lifetime of the project.
